Forklift Training Tips

It is vital that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety regulations are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to any question indicates a procedural weakness that could lead to damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected workers?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are annual inspections of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the type of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different attachments and uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working properly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to operate the equipment?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any equipment damage and forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
