Counterbalance Forklift Training Whitby - Counterbalance Forklift Training courses are always in high demand. The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift that is designed with a weight which counters the balance, evenly distributing the weight of the load across the arms of the forklift. Counterbalance forklifts are made so the weight on the lift is counterbalanced by the weight behind the centre of gravity. The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the forklift driver. This type of forklift truck should only be used on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift drivers are required to obtain training that will enable them to better understand the right or proper method across the forklift arms. The trainee would be taught to correctly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the lift truck mast, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both forwards and backwards. People training would learn the RTITB standards needed for operating the forklift safely. Trainees would likewise become familiar with the types of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

### Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into areas which are cramped and small. This lift is really maneuverable and capable of accessing almost whatever tight spot.

### Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker is a different forklift which differs somewhat from the Walkie Pallet truck when it comes to its lift height. This particular equipment is designed to access tighter spaces and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. None of the Walkie line of lifts could be ridden. The operator has to walk behind them.

### Rider Pallet Trucks

Rider Pallet Trucks are designed to be ridden. These riding lifts are great for dock loading and unloading.

### Wave Work Assist Vehicle

The Wave Work Assist Vehicle is a counterbalance forklift meant to reach great heights of as much as 17 feet.

### Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks

The Sit-down Counterbalance Forklift is built in four-wheel and three-wheel forklift designs. These durable and tough trucks are designed to be ridden.
