Aerial Lift Training Whitby - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This machinery provides access to otherwise inaccessible areas for people or equipment. Also known as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machine is usually used to be able to access high areas. Construction and maintenance staff normally should make use of aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters use them for emergency access.

Meant for temporary use, aerial work platforms are distinguished from elevators, that provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is designed to be operated by one person, and can lift weights of less than one ton. Some types have higher load limits. There are various types of aerial work platforms; for example, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

Some aerial work platforms come outfitted along with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, like for example lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come with special tools.

Anybody required to operate an aerial lifting device requires training, along with their bosses. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial machine work places also must go through training. Those training will know aerial lifting device operation. They will likewise learn the regulations that apply to safely utilizing these devices. Regulations differ in various provinces, and in federally regulated worksites.

Workers who are required to be lifted or work near an aerial lifting device should know all the potential hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the employees who are lifted by them or work near them.

Most Aerial Lift Training Program will include modules that are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is intended to train staff on the safe operation of boom-supported, self-propelled elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. Workers who complete the program would receive a certificate, signed by a person qualified to verify successfully finishing a hands-on practical exam.
